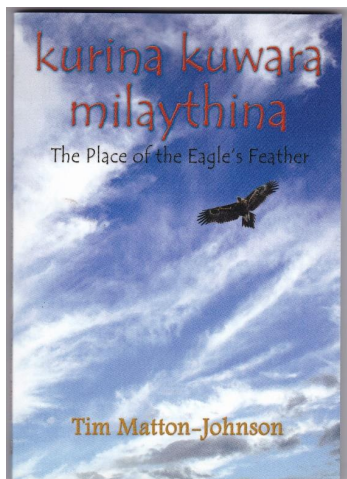

Everyone has doubts. And most people have some doubts about the Bible.
How can we read the creation accounts in Genesis in light of modern science?
How do we approach the Old Testament Law when it seems inconsistent and irrelevant? How can any intelligent person take the Bible seriously?

John Dickson will speak about *doubting the Bible* in this public talk and Q&A for sceptics and believers alike.



John Dickson is the Founding Director of the Centre for Public Christianity, Honorary Fellow of the Department of Ancient History at Macquarie University, and Senior Minister at St. Andrew's Roseville. The author of more than a dozen books, he is the host of two television history documentaries, a regular commentator in the media, and a frequent public speaker in corporations, universities, churches, and conferences. He lives in Sydney with his wife and three children.
