### **70 YEARS OF NAKBA - a VIGIL**

May 15 is when Palestinians and their supporters commemorate *The Nakba* (Arabic: *The Catastrophe*) where in 1948 up to 800,000 people were displaced and many were killed.

This year marks 70 years of ongoing Nakba, with continued displacement in Jerusalem, imprisonment of Palestinians and the horrific blockade of Gaza forefront.

Australians are passionate and active in solidarity - there will be **13 events surrounding Nakba70 - protests, vigils, parliamentary events and book launches.**
